The husband and wife team of Tom Hagen on keys and Cherie Lynn Hagen (drums, vocals), will be joined by the smooth crooning of vocalist Rick Reuther and Mike Lutley will add his magic on saxes and flute. This band can perform a wide variety of music, including jazz, pop, Broadway & big band, and they never fail to make a connection with their audience. The trio has one well received CD in release, titled "One". They perform for concerts, special events, night clubs and are a mainstay in the lounge at Notos in Grand Rapids, MI, performing every Wednesday evening.

Tom Hagen was voted West Michigan Jazz Society's Jazz Musician of the year in 2007. He has spent his life immersed in music, performing, recording, teaching, arranging and enjoying it all. He has played with Steve Allen, Buddy De Franco, the Grand Rapids

Symphony, The Lennon Bros., and much much more. Tom plays keyboards, guitar, bass, clarinet, tenor sax, alto sax, flute and more! Along with all that talent, and his great musical ear, he has a popular and busy recording studio in his home.

Cherie Lynn is one of the few female drummers in West Michigan, Cherie Lynn works steadily in the area with the Tom Hagen Trio and We Know Jack. She started out playing bass backing many musicians & vocalists in the area as well as celebrities that would come into Grand Rapids including Steve Allen, Kenny Loggins & Chaka Kahn to name a few. Cherie loves to write and has collaborated with Tom Hagen on three of the songs on her "Two for the Road" CD. Their original compositions are; "The Time I Spend With You", "You Make My Heart Dance" & "In Love With Love".

Vocalist Rick Reuther delivers a song with feeling and authority, learned and earned in a career of performing that spans more than thirty years. Confidence, an extremely engaging stage manner and excellent vocal chops combine to make this singer one you won't want to miss. Rick has several recordings out, one with the popular Grand Rapids based Mary Rademacher. Rick also composes and has written several songs for his recordings.

Mike Lutley is one of the most in demand and first call sax men in West Michigan. He plays consistently with many area bands including the Grand Rapids Jazz Orchestra. Mike composes, arranges and in his day job he makes sure Grand Rapids school instruments are in fine shape. Mike recently released his first solo CD "Double of Nothing", recorded at Tom's studio.



Matt was born in Oklahoma City but grew up mostly in Albuquerque, NM. He attended the Interlochen Arts Academy and college on full scholarship at the Juilliard School. He has toured and/or recorded with Greg Osby, Gonzalo Rubalcaba, David Sanchez, Terrence Blanchard, Vijay Iyer, Steve Coleman, Lee Konitz, Steve Lehman, Ambrose Akinmusurie, Jeff "Tain" Watts, Dave Binney, Antonio Sanchez, Aaron Parks, Logan Richardson, Lage Lund, Mike Moreno, Will Vinson, Adam Rogers and many others. Criss-Cross Records recently released his debut CD as a bandleader and composer: Mythology.

Matt has been an adjunct faculty member at the New School University and has taught several times at the Banff International Workshop in Jazz and Creative Music.
