Guitarist Greg Miller is a respected performer and educator who has performed at the Blue Bird Café in Nashville, and Kenny's Castaway

in New York, as well as internationally at venues including the Berlin Opera House. Twice awarded the ASCAP Award for his song writing with the band Dutch Henry, Vintage Guitar Magazine called him a "top notch musician", and praised his mix of "hot country guitar with melodic hints of Jazz" playing style. He regularly works with the Grand Rapids and Kalamazoo Symphonies as well as professional theater companies where he has supported artists including Matt Giraud and Dee Dee Bridgewater. While Miller continues to write and perform, he is a faculty member in the music department at Muskegon Community College.

On Monday, September 19, our Jazz Gumbo kicked off the new season with a bang. Relative newcomer to the West Michigan performance scene, vocalist Amy Williams wowed the audience with a tasteful assortment of musical selections.

Her core quartet consisted of Mark Kahny on piano, Bob Thompson, Jr. on drums, Robbie Jewitt on acoustic bass and Freddy DeGennaro on guitar. Surprises were scattered throughout the evening, beginning with Mary Rademacher Reed and Kathleen Jones joining Amy on stage to perform "Sentimental Journey" a la Andrews Sisters vocal trio. Other jewels from the evening included talented alto sax man, Bob Hartig sitting in on several numbers, and WMJS's own Program Director, Jerry Scott, adding a splash of color to many tunes with his crafty conga work.

The 50/50 raffle for the scholarship fund was one of the largest to date, and the winner, Mary Catherine Vierheilig generously donated her winnings back to help grow that fund! A couple of highlights of the performance included Amy singing her original composition, "Red Wing Blackbird", and Jewitt's bowed bass introduction to "You Don't Know Me". Amy said, "Sometimes the best magical moments happen when performing something entirely unplanned", as was the case with her closer 'Stand By Me'. "It felt like a community kumbaya moment. I felt so completely accepted and welcomed."




