Monday Night Jazz Gumbo 2019 WMJS's Gumbo series is once again moving. The concerts will be at the Casino Club located at 3260 Salerno Drive NE, just off the Plainfield exit on I 96, beginning in January.

The venue can accommodate 250 people, so there will be no need for reservations in advance! There is unlimited free parking at the facility! The stage is large and raised so anywhere you sit you will have an unobstructed view of the band!

Jennifer Idema, our beloved and popular 'hot dog lady' from Jazz in the Park concert series, will be providing the food! The choices will be gumbo or soup served with salad and bread, or hot dogs and chips. This meal will be cafeteria style and included in the cost of your ticket. The Casino Club will be manning the bar and we will be offered their membership prices for drinks! (ex. top shelf drinks are around \$3.50, wine and mixed drinks are \$2.50-3.00)

You notice all the!!!!? Yes, we are excited! This is a private club that has agreed to rent us the space for

our series. We have not had to pay rent for a space before, but we believe the perks at the Casino Club make it so worth it. Even though ticket prices need to increase, we believe with the low cost of food and drinks along with fine music, you will not find a better bargain anywhere!

The new entrance fee will be \$15.00 for members, \$20.00 for non-members. If you choose not to get a food ticket, the price will be \$5.00 less. Times remain the same with doors opening at 6, concert time 6:30-8:30pm.

After his stellar performance in the November concert with Elgin Vines, WMJS fans are eager to hear Paul Brewer as the featured artist in this first concert of 2019! Paul will play trombone and sing (I've heard Paul now referred to as the Chet Baker of the trombone in Grand Rapids!). He will be joined by pianist vocalist

Robin Connell. bassist Rob Hartman and Eddie Eicher on drums.

Sneak peek! The program Jazz and the American Songbook will feature songs of the 1930s through

the 1960s. Featured songwriters will be Irving Berlin (Change Partners), Vernon Duke (Autumn In New York), Richard Rodgers (The Lady Is A Tramp), George Gershwin (But Not For Me), Duke Ellington (I Ain't Got Nothin' But The Blues), Henry Nemo ('Tis Autumn),

Henry Mancini (The Days of Wine and Roses), Johnny Mandel (The Shadow of Your Smile), Ann Ronell (Willow Weep For Me), Ruth Lowe (I'll Never Smile Again), and many others.

Originally from Oklahoma, Paul continues to be 'first call trombonist' with touring shows and regional jazz musicians. He has appeared in concert with over fifty major artists, including Mel Torme, Milt Jackson, Lena Horne, Bob Hope, The Temptations, Leon Russell, and Mickey Rooney. He performs with, and composes for, the Grand Rapids Jazz Orchestra, the Gull Lake Big Band, and other groups. Paul is the Director of Instrumental Music at Aquinas College and the Aguinas Jazz Camp and has taught at Interlochen Arts Camp for 22 summers. Also, a scholar and jazz historian, he is gaining a following of 'lifelong learners' through the Ollie program at Aquinas College.

Robin Connell tickles the ivories with original arrangements of time-honored jazz standards and her own compositions. Among her current endeavors, Robin hosts a jazz concert series, Jazz in the

> Sanctuary at Fountain Street Church. co-directs the St Cecilia Youth Jazz Ensembles, and gives lectureperformances on the Great American Songbook.

Rob Hartman is a former

> bassist for the world-famous Glenn Miller Orchestra. He regularly plays with the John Shea Trio. Rob graduated from Grand Valley State University with a degree in Computer Science

and during the day he is a software engineer at SpinDance. (Right brain/left brain intelligence, with a great smile!)

Eddie Eicher is a drummer who gets around. He plays and has played with many well-known groups and combos including an organ trio with Cliff Metcalf

and Neil Gorden, Hip Pocket, Alive and Well, Beer City Saxes, the Grand Rapids Jazz Orchestra and the newly formed Holland Concert Jazz Orchestra. Eddie has also written original compositions.

The Thelonious Monk Institute of Jazz, established in 1986 in Washington DC, will change its name in 2019 to become 'The Herbie Hancock Institute of Jazz'. The Board of Trustees announced the news yesterday following a conversation with representatives of the Monk Estate. The decision was unanimous, as they praised the legendary pianist and 14-time Grammy winner for his "immense contributions to and impact on music, education and humanity". Hancock has been the Chairman of the Institute for the last 15 years. he's a UNESCO Goodwill Ambassador and founder of International Jazz Day held every April 30th.

Sir Van Morrison has confirmed that his 40th studio album will be released in December - it's his second this year and again he's working with the acclaimed jazz organist and trumpeter Joey De Francesco. The new project is called 'The Prophet Speaks' and will feature six original compositions from the pair alongside covers written by Sam Cooke, John Lee Hooker, Solomon Burke and more. At the age of 73, he told Jazz FM: "It was important for me to get

back to recording new music as well as doing some of the blues material that has inspired me from the beginning. Writing songs and making music is what I do, and working with great musicians makes it all the more enjoyable."

Gregory Porter will release his first British live album and DVD this Christmas season; a recording of his concert at London's Royal Albert Hall on 2 April 2018. It features a selection of his most recognized songs. alongside his Nat King Cole tribute material (including 'Mona Lisa', 'L-O-V-E' and 'Smile' plus 'The Christmas Song'), all of which propelled him to be the biggest selling jazz musician of 2017. The show featured his longstanding jazz trio with accompaniment from a full 70-piece symphony orchestra, conducted by the Grammy-winning arranger Vince Mendoza. The album is called 'One Night Only' and released on November 30th.

as two pianos. Unfortunately, Dave Proulx could not make it, as he had a severe sore throat resulting in losing his voice. However, this gave brother John the opportunity to use the new grand piano, which he did with great skill and delivery. John Proulx is a jazz pianist, vocalist, and Grammy Award-winning composer and a MAXJAZZ recording artist. He was joined by Dave Rosin on bass and Fred Knapp on drums. When the band was featured, there were great solos by both Dave and Fred. The trio did their usual fine jobs, mixing old standards with more contemporary tunes. John (a la Chet Baker?) sang with sincere appeal on many ballads including "Embraceable You" and "Nature Boy". He was equally adept at swinging on the uptempo tunes.

John has an easy-going style both in singing and speaking. The trio was tight, very enjoyable and delivered a full night of great jazz and entertainment. Many tunes were featured numbers from John's new album, "Say It". Favorites of the evening included "There is No Greater Love" and "Scatsville", a Michael Franks tune. They performed a jazzy, laid back version of Sing (Sing a Song) with some interesting chord changes. A fun tune, "Proulx's







Blues" - had everyone singing along with the hook line - "the more harder I work, the behinder I get".

John also sang "Stuck in a Dream with Me"- a beautiful ballad he wrote for his wife, Anna. A definite feather in his cap is that this past October John performed in New York City at Birdland and presented "Here to Stay", a music tribute to Ira and George for the Gershwin family.

This second installment of the series at the Old Goat proved to have some of the issues we had with the first concert ironed out. but not all. All seats were on the main level, albeit at the expense of a dance floor, and the place was packed. Once again, we had a great turnout of enthusiastic jazz lovers. For the second month in a row, the concert sold out and unfortunately, we had to turn some people away. The owner and staff at the restaurant are most supportive of our jazz series and are doing their best to make it go well. It was a fine night of music, although we missed Dave and the chance to hear the brothers' dueling it out on keys.


