Currently, Houston is studying Jazz Saxophone at the University of Michigan and is preparing for much more in the future. At 21 he is getting ready to take the world by storm!

June 26 - Andrew Rathbun Quartet



Saxophonist, composer, and Toronto native Andrew Rathbun has achieved a rare depth of lyricism and compositional intelligence in 20 years as a recording artist; Ben Ratliff of the New York Times described Rathbun as "an industrious saxophonist and imaginative composer-arranger." Voted as a "Rising Star" in the 2018 and 2022 Downbeat Critics Polls, he has documented his stirring original music with a series of acclaimed recordings, on the Challenge, Fresh Sound and Steeplechase labels, and has collaborated with musicians like Kenny Wheeler, Billy Hart, Ben Monder Bill Stewart, and Luciana Souza. "Rathbun's lines dance and glide," writes David Whiteis of JazzTimes, "reflecting both childlike wonder and well-honed artistry."

After hearing 2014's Numbers & Letters the New Yorker declared Rathbun "a crafty saxophonist and composer whose ambitious work over the past decade has eluded the wider recognition it deserves." Atwood Suites, Rathbun's JUNOnominated jazz-orchestra project was summarized in Jazziz Magazine; "On the basis of this CD alone, Rathbun deserves to be ranked among today's top arranger- composers." His latest recordings include NODES, Northern Noir with the legendary pianist Ran Blake, and Semantics, which finds Rathbun with tenor sax great Rich Perry, and jazz percussion icon Billy Drummond.

July 10 - BIG BAND NOUVEAU



A newer big band on the Grand Rapids scene, this 19 piece group's musical presentation is a continuation of hard bop and modern mainstream jazz. Their library covers a variety of very modern jazz styles including some Latin along with original compositions and arrangements written by some of the musicians in the band. Their performing credits include the GRandjazz fest, Thornapple Arts Council Jazz Festival, Lowell Showboat Showcase, and the Michigan Jazz Festival. Created by saxophonist, Michael Doyle, conducted by Thomas Pollett.

July 17 - Third Coast Swing



Third Coast Swing has been playing the music of The late Belgium born Romani Gypsy, Django Reinhardt & his band, The Hot Club Of Paris 1930'-1940's. Think Louis Armstrong with a French accent. Third Coast Swing has changed it up a bit and is currently touring with the Detroit native Dave Bennett, Violinist Grant Flick, Vocalist Ella Jury Jarvis & Pianist Andrew Henley. Ella and our guitarist Kaedin Plummer did a deep dive on early jazz classics by Fitzgerald, Sarah Vaughan and Billy Holiday and then we arranged these songs to fit Third Coast Swings style.

July 24 - Jordan Anderson Trio



Jordan Anderson is an up and coming pianist and composer based in Minneapolis who is making his mark in southeast Michigan. He is a recent graduate of the University of Mich igan's jazz studies program and worked as a student of Benny

Green and Andy Milne. Jordan's musical approach focuses on combining modern and traditional storytelling techniques through the vehicle of straight-ahead jazz. His passion and dedication to the tradition of black American music has led to performances with Charles McPherson, Irv Williams, Francisco Mela, Charlie Gabriel, Shannon Powell, Robert Hurst, and Justin Robinson.

July 31 - Steve Talaga Trio



Pianist, composer, arranger, and educator Steve Talaga has been performing professionally for more than 40 years. He is very active appearing as a solo artist and clinician, and as a member of many ensembles in the West Michigan area.

Talaga was chosen as the West Michigan Jazz Society's 2008 Jazz Musician of the Year, and has released eight compact discs under his own name: "Mirage;" "Yin-Yang;" "Basement Alchemy" (which was chosen as best release of 2000 by Lazaro Vega at WBLV-FM); "Two Worlds;" "Contemplating the Heavens" (a companion to the poetry chapbook of the same title by Linda Nemec Foster); "Heartside Sketches" (featuring a suite commissioned by MAJIC of Grand Rapids) which won the WYCE-FM "Jammie" Award for Best Jazz Album of 2010; "The Shapeshifter," which includes "Deadman's Hill," for which Talaga won third place in the 2011 International Songwriting Competition (jazz category); and, most recently, "June Balloon."

Before retiring from teaching in 2020, he had served on music faculties at Hope College, Aquinas College, Grand Valley State University, Grace Bible College, and Cornerstone University. Visit him on the web at www.stevetalaga.com.
