Ivan Akansiima is a Christian and a Ugandan born Jazz pianist with a BA in music performance from Hope College Holland MI, and a Master's Degree in Jazz Performance. He is a multi-instrumentalist, a composer, music arranger, worship leader, biblical teacher, and music instructor. His music style draws from biblical spirituality and faith and combines indigenous Ugandan and African rhythms with Jazz music traits that are historically rooted in African music traditions.

### **Lisa Sung Group**

Ms. Sung holds a Bachelor of Jazz piano performance from Temple University,

Philadelphia, performed in the top band under trumpeter Terrell Stafford.

She also holds a Master of Jazz Performance from New York University. She studied composition with Ron McClure, Dave Schroeder and studied jazz piano with Thomas Lawton, Don Friedman and Don Glanden.

She has performed with bassist Ron McClure, drummer Jeff Brillanger, and saxophonist Patrick Wolf. She has also performed a weekly duo with bassist/vocalist Gerald Benson in Philadelphia, New Jersey, and in New York. Coming to Grand Rapids, Ms. Sung has been serving as the music director for the Calvin University Gospel Choir and teaches jazz piano at Hope College and

Calvin University. Ms. Sung also has been a regular member at the Central Michigan University jazz faculty concert series.



### [Bill and Laurie] Sears and Sears Quintet

The saxophone stylings of Bill and Laurie Sears have been electrifying jazz audiences

in Northern Michigan and throughout the state since their move to Traverse City in 1987. Each has forged individual careers, but it is when they combine their unique and individual musical voices in the Sears and Sears Quintet that their chemistry shines. Collectively they have graced the stage with a veritable "Who's Who" of jazz and popular music including Ray Charles, Dizzy Gillespie, Bob James, Nancy Wilson, Natalie Cole, Aretha Franklin, Johnny Mathis, Frank Sinatra, The Temptations and countless others. Laurie can be heard regularly as the featured saxophonist with the Jeff Haas Trio appearing at Chateau Chantal Winery, The



Union in Northport and most recently the newly opened Alluvion in Traverse City, in addition to leading her own groups. Bill can be heard Wednesday's at the Workshop Brewing Company in Traverse City, occasionally joining Laurie with Jeff Haas, and leading a quartet at various venues in and around the Traverse City region. Both are charter members of the Traverse Symphony Jazz Orchestra and perform often with the Grand Rapids Symphony.

### Jeff Shoup Group featuring singer, Freddie Cunningham

Jeff Shoup is a drummer and music educator based in Lansing, MI, and is the host of the weekly music series Jazz Tuesdays at Moriarty's Pub. Joining Jeff in the trio we have Hammond organist Jim Alfredson, who is well-known internationally for his highly successful band organissimo, and the great Detroit guitarist Ralph Tope.

Vocalist Freddie Cunningham is the driving force behind the legendary Michiganbased blues band Root Doctor. After (mostly) retiring from touring with Root Doctor, Mr. Cunningham has enjoyed putting his own bluesy stamp on the jazz standard song book.






### **Keller/Kocher Quartet with Mary Rademacher**

Each year, West Michigan Vocalist and Entertainer Mary Rademacher\* thinks long and hard about the group she puts together for her very special Jazz in the Park date. Quality, variety, musical friendship and showmanship are vying factors.

This year presented an opportunity to put together some of her favorite and long time friends - The Keller Kosher Quartet.

Selections such as the title song; along with Perhaps, Perhaps, You and the Night and the Music, 3 Coins in The Fountain, My Echo, My Shadow & Me from the album may be a part of this wonderfully entertaining concert, along with great vocal and instrumental arrangements by Keller and Kosher. The talented local drummer and singer, Fred Knapp\* will be joining, as well. Strap in - you're in for a treat!





### **Grand Rapids Jazz Orchestra**

For over 45 years, The Grand Rapids Jazz Orchestra has been one of Michigan's premier jazz ensembles, featuring some of the finest musicians in the area playing swinging original compositions and arrangements as well as traditional favorites.



The musicians that create the live sounds are some of the area's best soloists, sidemen, and educators available. Many have jazz projects of their own, yet dedicate time to fostering the performance of live big band jazz.

The band was founded in 1976 by the late Bruce Early, and has performed with many famous artists such as Clark Terry, Louis Bellson, Phil Woods, Pearl Bailey, Kenny Wheeler, Randy Brecker, Maria Schneider, Allen Vizutti, Phil Wilson, Bobby Shew, and has been enjoyed by thousands of people at concerts, dances, and festivals throughout the region.
