"Wish it was on a bus line..." many echoed the sentiment. Shannan wondered about getting the Go bus. Kevin reiterated that he is on the board to help advocate for people who don't have access: people on the west side, south east side, wherever....not that we should change venues right away but how can we be at a place with access, also for Jazz Gumbos. Mary suggested maybe going to one of those parks for an event. Jim added that the fundraiser could facilitate some of this stuff.
